We had some cold days recently, which is good in some sense . My parents are busy (probably too busy) in the gardens. Recently, they awoke to a little "tragedy." Apparently, my dad forgot to shut the cage where a couple of ducks were kept and both of them were killed by "something." I tell you, it is a real war zone in a lot of respects. Everything has to be well-fenced off and shut for the night. It reminds me of a spiritual warfare that goes on around us. It is no less vicious. Praise be to God for deliverance through His Captain of our salvation!



The church is going well. However, I have several difficult counseling situations. Last week I was in Szczecin (also northern Poland) at an Evangelical Church. The last 20 years I have been assisting that church through various trials. The church started a school for leaders. I was teaching on preaching and on cults. Quite a few people attended. It was interesting getting to Szczecin -the train I was traveling on broke down. Fortunately, there was another one coming by shortly.



We have two newly-born girls in our church now - Zosia and Lilia. Please pray for two 17-year old men in our church - that the Lord will shield them as they are facing various pressures (especially at their schools.)

I am talking my parents to the coast for a week and I don't have air conditioning in my car. It is about an hour drive north to the Baltic Sea.
