A Non-Refundable Registration Fee of \$80 is due along with the Registration Form in order to hold your child's spot. This fee will cover supplies and snacks for the year.



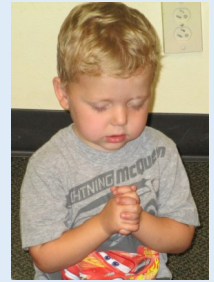
We operate on a 1:7 student/teacher ratio with a maximum of 28 students per day. Class includes shared times in all four rooms with multiple ages, as well as separation into smaller classes to maximize learning at age-appropriate levels.

Philosophy and Curriculum Goals

Sonshine provides a loving, welcoming atmosphere where your child's needs will be met spiritually, academically, socially and physically.

Spiritual Focus

We believe that God is the creator of everything, and that Jesus Christ is our Savior who died on the cross for our sins. Through this selfless act He gives us the perfect example of how to show love, kindness and forgiveness toward others.



Academic Focus

We will be utilizing different mediums and hands-on activities to teach the following concepts: letters, phonics, recognizing and counting numbers, basic math, sequencing, patterning, graphing, shapes, colors, the color wheel, and writing numbers and letters.

Social Skill Focus

Our goal is to help your child build upon their social skills by working on playing cooperatively in a variety of settings with other children. Also, to learn to follow simple rules and tasks (hand washing, restroom, etc) and ultimately realize and understand there is a world outside of self.

Gross and Fine Motor Skill Focus

Movement activities will be offered each day. There is time for both free play and organized games to increase gross motor skills. Fine motor skills will be introduced and challenged using various manipulatives and art mediums.
