**Scene 1: Well-intentioned idea, but faulty process (1-11)**

**Background**

**David shortcuts the details to get things done and makes a terrible mistake.**

- God doesn't accept man's way of doing religion.
- God makes the rules and we are blessed when we follow them.
- Are poles and rings important to us? They are important to God.

**Scene 2: Right process brings right results (12-15)**

**David gets it right the second time!**

1 Chronicles 15:1-13

**Are we excited and passionate for the things of God?**

**Scene 3: A focus on what man thinks and not a passion for God's things (16-23)**

**“Was David Dancing in His Tighty Whities?”**

Was Michal correct in despising her husband's behavior?

What was David's response? It was before the Lord (not concerned about pleasing people)
